II. DISCUSSION

a. Rule 64B13-4.001, Florida Administrative Code

Ms. Guillemette began by explaining the changes contained in her proposed draft, which change the rule to reflect the National Board of Optometric Examiners (NBEO) taking over the development and administration of the Florida Laws and Rules Examination (also referred to as Part IV of the licensure examination).

After discussion, the board agreed to make certain changes to Ms. Guillemette's proposal. First, they added the language "The board shall approve the content of the laws and rules examination annually" to the end of part (1)(d) of the rule. The board also agreed to amend part (2) of the rule to state "passing scores on Part I, Part II, and Part III, and Part IV of the licensure examination must be obtained within the seven (7) year period immediately preceding licensure application to take Part IV of the licensure examination." Finally, the board agreed to replace "Board of Optometry" with "the board" in all occurances of such language because "Board of Optometry" had already been established as "the board" within the rule chapter.

Board action: Motion to accept the proposed language of Rule 64B13-4.001, F.A.C. with the noted changes was made by Dr. Kaplan. Seconded by Mr. Presnell.

Vote: 5 yeas / 0 opposed; motion carried

Ms. Guillemette then asked the board to open Rules 64B13-4.002, 4.003, and 4.006, F.A.C. for development to make the necessary changes to ensure consistency with the new language of Rule 64B13-4.001, F.A.C.

Board action: Motion to open Rules 64B13-4.002, 4.003, and 4.006, F.A.C. for development was made by Dr. King. Seconded by Dr. Kaplan.

Vote: 5 yeas / 0 opposed; motion carried

Ms. Guillemette then asked the board if the proposed changes to Rule 64B13-4.001, F.A.C. would have an adverse impact on small business, or be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs in the amount \$200,000 in the aggregate in the state of Florida within one year of implementation.

Dr. Underhill stated that the response is "no," and asked for a motion.

Board action: Motion to respond "no" to the question presented by Ms. Guillemette was made by Dr. Kaplan. Seconded by Dr. Spear.

Vote: 5 yeas / 0 opposed; motion carried
