An Administrative complaint was filed alleging that the respondent failed to perform dilation on a patient during a comprehensive eye examination. Upon the department's investigation, it was determined that the Respondent was not in violation due to having performed dilation on the patient on initial visit within the past 3 years. Dr. Underhill discussed his concerns with Dr. Wainwright. The department requested that the case be dismissed.

Board action: Motion to dismiss the case against Brenda Wainwright made by Dr. Underhill. Second made by Dr. Spear.

R-02 Albert Evans, OD

Dr. Evans was not present on the call, nor was represented by legal representation.

Ms. Kimberly Marshall presented case number 2012-15585. An Administrative complaint was filed alleging false advertisement in which probable cause was found (Count 1). Upon the department's investigation, it was determined that Dr. Evans was also in violation of multiple statutes including insurance billing for services not rendered (Count 2).

Board action: Motion to find probable cause on the Count 2 and direct the filing of an amended administrative complaint against Albert Evans made by Dr. Underhill. Second made by Dr. Spear.
