II. NATIONAL BOARD EXAMINERS IN OPTOMETRY (NBEO) UPDATE

Ms. McGinnis provided a brief update of the Board's previous ask of the board office to reach out to NBEO to see if they would provide the individual skill level to the department from the diagnostics score report. NBEO stated that the report is for the candidate only and it's meant to help them recognize any areas may need improvement. They do not share the diagnostic report with any other state board offices. In addition, they do support using individual skill competency determination from this score report without a standard setting to substantiate the use of the scores in that manner.

III. NATIONAL BORD EXAM REVIEW COMMITTEE (NBERC) UPDATE: DR. ROUSE

Dr. Rouse provided an update of his recent visit with NBERC. He stated the communication that we've had with this national board to date revolve around the ability to have an exam standard for the critical skills portion as we have interpreted since 2013. When the change went into effect the discussions were clear and the fact that it isn't applicable to the way the exam was set up and standardized. If this is the board's intent to continue to have some skills portions as part of licensure the new parts portion of the examination that's going live in 2023 or maybe 2024 could be standardized to do what the board was originally intending for it to do and if the board wishes that it wants to be standardized in that format, they're able and willing to do so but would do so at this direction of the board.
